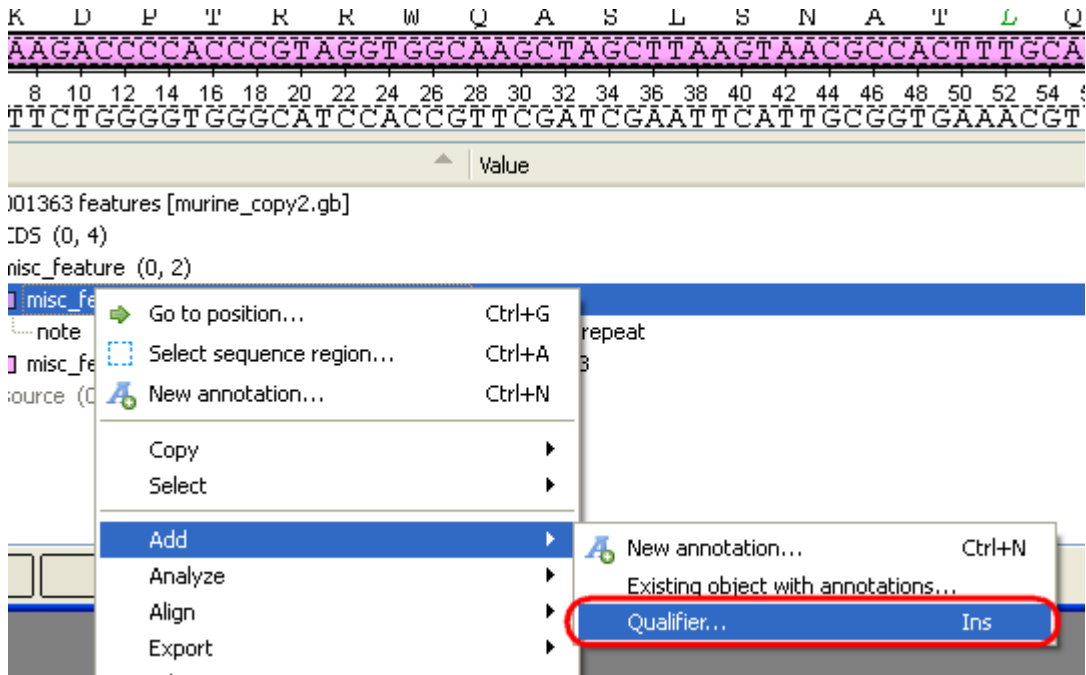
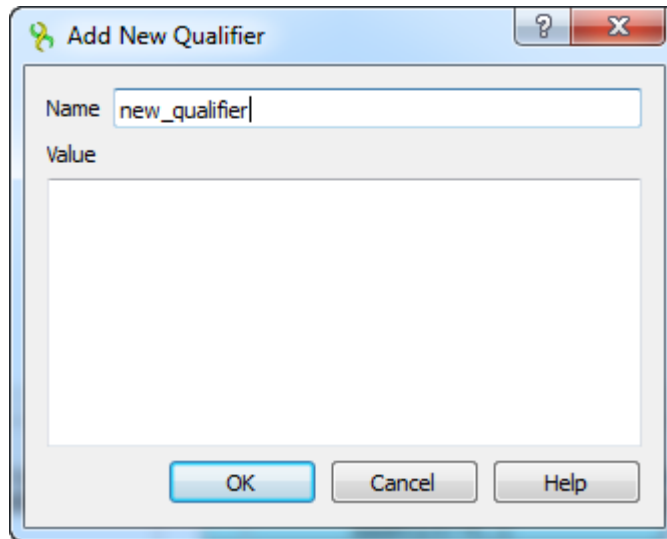


Creating and Editing Qualifier

To add a qualifier to an annotation select it in one of the *Sequence View* subviews and press the Insert key, or use the *Add Qualifier* context menu or the *Annotations* main menu item.

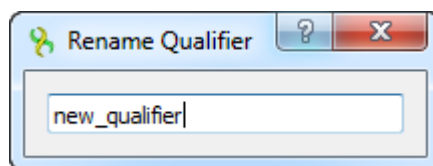


The dialog will appear:



Here you can specify the name and the value of the qualifier.

You can use the F2 key to rename a qualifier:



To edit a qualifier, select the qualifier and press the F4 key or use the *Edit qualifier* context menu item:
